Dear Parents,

Taking place on November 7 this year in accordance to the Hindu lunar calendar is India's biggest festival, Diwali. The word itself is derived from the Sanskrit word "deepavali," meaning "series of lighted lamps," hence, it is also known as the festival of lights. For most Hindus, Diwali marks the return of deities, Rama and Sita to Ayodhya after 14 years of exile. To celebrate their return, villagers lighted oil lamps that illuminated the path in the darkness. For others, the festival is linked to Lakshmi – goddess of wealth and prosperity – and her birth on the first day of the 5 day-long event. It is an important occasion that marks the victory of light over darkness, knowledge over ignorance, and good over evil.

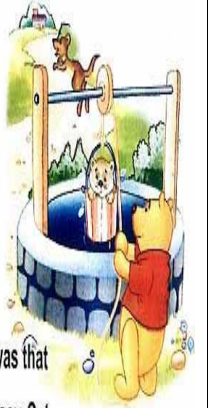
